


Join Us Down by the Creek! May 2022

Description

It's time to explore your urban waterway. The Mill Creek runs right through the heart of Cincinnati and is packed with nature – beavers, herons, many species of fish and invertebrates – but also bears the scars from human development and degradation. Come see the tug of war between humans and nature playing out before your eyes. (Hint: Nature is very resilient, and Mother Nature always bats last.)

This trip will cover about 1.7 miles of creek starting in Evendale paddling about 1 hour down to Reading. Feel free to extend your trip by stopping to play or explore along the way. At the end of the route, paddlers can catch a ride in our van back to the put-in. In addition, paddlers could stage a bicycle at the takeout before canoeing and pedal back to the start (on street, no bike trail).
