Have you heard of our **Jean Alva Goldsmith Collection**? Jean Alva Goldsmith was born on September 7, 1922 in Avondale, however she unexpectedly passed away days before seventh birthday, on August 29, 1929. She developed a deep love of reading and even insisted her family celebrate her half birthdays to receive more books as gifts.

Shortly after her passing, the family of Jean Alva donated her collection of several hundred books to the Library. Her family also established a trust, with funds donated to the library twice annually for the purchase and addition of quality children's books for her collection. A century after Jean Alva's birth, we continue to add to her collection through the trust and celebrate her love of reading.


