1. Introductions of NANA Board Members
2. Approval of meeting minutes from May 2022
3. District 4 Police Report: Sgt. Jeff Meister - Officer Hill will no longer be the liaison officer. A new Officer will be assigned this Summer. Crime that was discussed was the shooting at 970 Dana Ave. and auto thefts. It was asked from general members that the new assigned officer give more detailed crime reports with locations and statistical trends.

Crosswalk on Mitchell discussed. Traffic plan is being approved by the city. Reading Rd traffic was discussed as well.

4. Committees - Law and Safety, Beautification, Membership, Social, and Strategic Development. Once all of these committees have chairs, the general body will vote as to whether the committee chairs will have voting rights at NANA board meetings.

ad hoc committee chairs will not have voting rights - Zoning, NANA/NABA liaison.

5. New website coming. Hoping to aid in news, membership dues, and general organization.
6. Eden Urban Gardens - April Pandora. Farm box subscriptions discussed. There is an urban garden on Clinton Springs.
7. Beautification - \$2,000, budget was approved at the board meeting to make irrigation repairs. There is a need for volunteer gardeners and welcome wagon members.
8. Zoning - Walt Koucky. Plans to update the 1975 Community Master Plan and 1995 Reading Rd corridor plan. The goal is to work with the city, and particularly with zoning, to make sure the development of North Avondale reflects the intentions and goals of the general body, which is to build a vibrant, diverse, safe, and prosperous neighborhood.
9. Rosemary's Babies has received approval from the City and is now sitting with the county port. This continues to be an evolving situation of which the details have been obfuscated from NANA and NABA.
