Description

Trees and gardens in our community work hard to clean the air and filter stormwater in North Avondale. Paddock Hills and North Avondale tree canopy coverage at 43.7% is the 7th highest in the neighborhoods assessed. With the exception of traffic exposure **moderate** and diesel particulate in the air **high**, all other built environment indicators for air, water, and land pollution are deemed either **very high** or **extreme**.

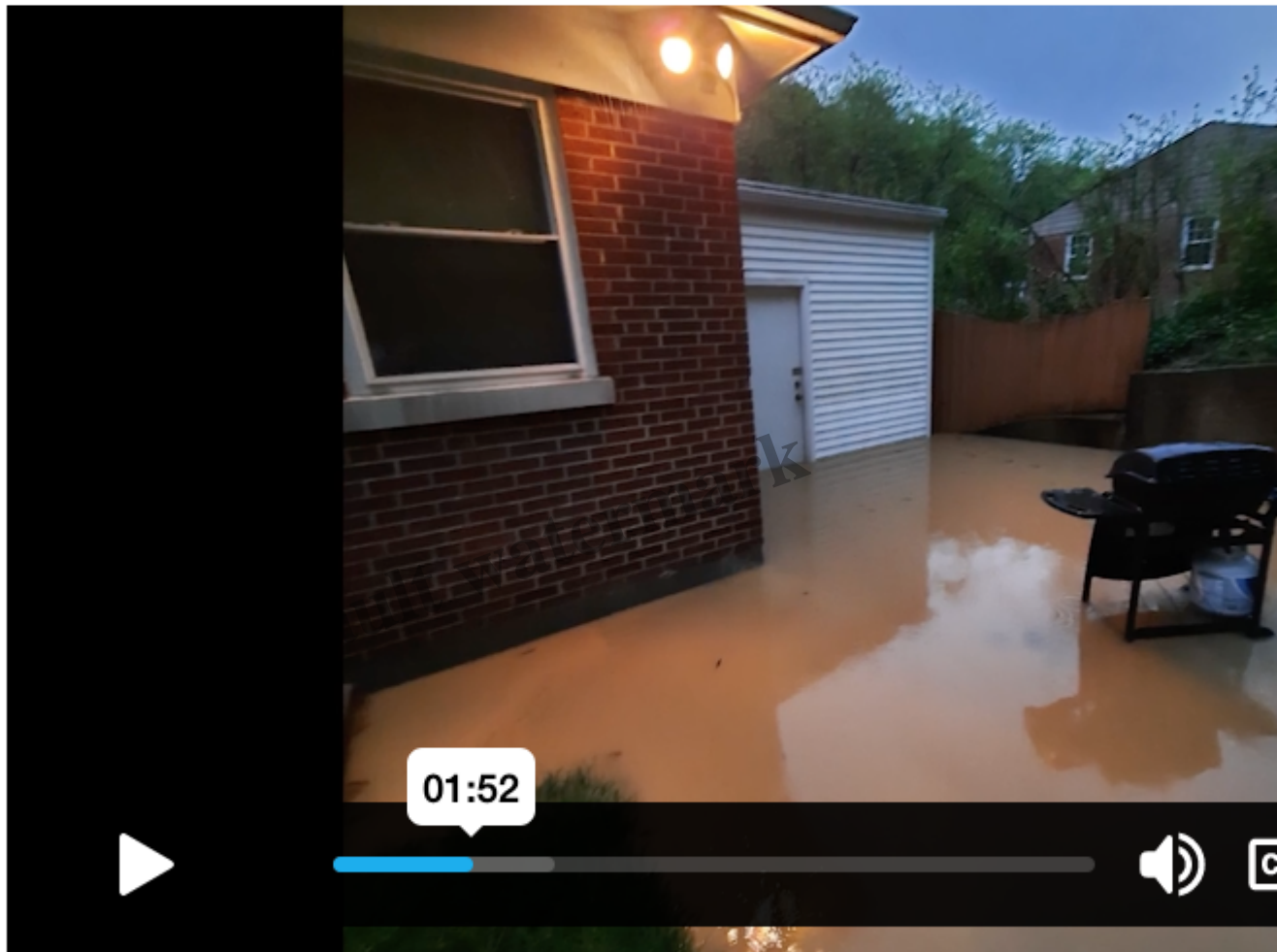
